Good Beginnings

- -show, don't tell
- -begin in the middle of the action (not at the literal beginning of the story, you can fill in details as you go along)
- -use a lot of action at the beginning
- -Use a creative title
- -Introduce characters
- -Withhold important details to make your reader want to read on (Create suspense)
- -Ask a question
- -Say something unusual
- -Make the reader want to figure out what will happen next
- -Start with a metaphor, simile or analogy
- -Start with a striking or controversial statement
- -Describe something in vivid detail (ie. the setting)
- -The ending should usually some how tie back to the beginning
- -Set a mood
- -Use 1st or 3rd person narration
